

Electronics Use Policy

The Lummi Nation School provides electronic resources for education and research in support of the Xwlemi Education mission.

Computers, user files, the e-mail system, and software furnished to students are the property of the LNS intended for educational purposes. Students are responsible for all LNS property issued to them. All LNS property must be returned immediately upon request.

LNS purchases and licenses the use of various computer software for education purposes and does not own the copyright to this software or its related documentation. Unless authorized by the software developer, LNS does not have the right to reproduce such software for use on more than one computer.

Students may only use software on local area networks according to the software license agreement. LNS prohibits the illegal duplication of software and its related documentation.

Students should notify their teacher or an administrator upon learning of violations of this policy. Students who violate this policy may be subject to disciplinary action, including suspension or loss of computer access privilege.

Personal Electronics (music, speakers, gaming, or other devises) may not be used on school property.

Electronic devices, including cell phones and headphones/earbuds, are not permitted for use during class time, meetings, and group activities except when needed as required for accommodation previously documented in students' records. Otherwise, they may only be used during non-instructional times, such as before and after school and at lunch time. If they are on or in use at any other time, disciplinary action may be enforced.

All students are expected to respect and care for all LNS and personal property. Any student found damaging school property will be expected to pay to repair the damage.
