



Disclosure of Student Directory Information

It is the policy of the Lummi Nation School to provide families the opportunity to consent to disclosure of student “directory” information to third parties. Directory Information may be made public without the consent of parent/guardians, according to the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act. “Directory information” is typically contained in the education records and is not generally considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if disclosed.

Upon request the school may disclose the following directory information: student’s name, address, telephone number, date and place of birth, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, and dates of attendance.

Parents and eligible students have the right to restrict the disclosures of directory information annually by granting the permission to release of all or some of their directory information through the annual student application with the school admissions office.
